LANDSCAPE USES

Native to Baja California, this climber makes a beautiful rose pink floral display from mid summer to fall. Also known as Rosa de Montana and Queen's Wreath, Coral Vine is a drought tolerant perennial that dies back at the onset of winter temperatures, but sprouts anew in spring. Plant in full sun (tolerates desert heat) with other summer flowering plants like *Trixis californica*, *Abutilon palmeri*, *Penstemon spectabilis*, *Trichostema lanatum* and *Tagetes lemmonii*. Coral Vine also combines well with fan palms, sugar bush and rushes to create an "oasis" effect.
